WHEREAS on October 12, 2022, the Board of Trustee affirmed the Design Review Board's recommendation of approval of the application of Lisa Wong and Timothy Lewis, 4 Sheffield Road, Thomaston for a sun room in the

rear yard, which included a recommendation to shingle the roof and install vinyl siding on the sunroom to match the existing single-family home, for which the expediter and owners agreed, and

WHEREAS, following the installation of the sunroom by the owners' contractor, Four Seasons, the "Contractor," the owners' were notified by the Contractor that any modification of the sunroom would void the manufacturer's warranty, and

WHEREAS, the owners did not wish to have the manufacture's warranty voided by installing vinyl siding and roof shingles to match the existing single-family home, made a request to the Design Review Board to amend their recommendation with respect to such installations,

WHEREAS, the Design Review Board considered the owners' request to amend the October 12, 2022 recommendation at their meeting on May 25, 2023 and voted unanimously to delete its previous recommendation to remove the stipulation to install roof shingles and vinyl siding, and add a new recommendation to plant yew shrubs (evergreens) around the bottom of the sunroom to "break up" the white panels.
