§ 203-107 Fences. [Added 11-27-1990 by L.L. No. 11-1990]

- A. No fence shall be erected or installed which exceeds a height of six feet above the existing natural grade on any property in a residential district.
- B. Except where expressly required by law, no fence shall be permitted in any district other than a residential district, except with the permission of the Board of Trustees; provided, however, that the Building Inspector may authorize a temporary fence to protect or safeguard a construction or demolition site for one or more periods of time not to exceed 30 days each. - C. No fence shall be erected or installed in a front yard.
- D. Any fence permitted by this chapter shall be constructed and maintained in a workmanlike manner. Any fence permitted by this chapter shall have a finished side facing out toward the nearest property line of the premises on which the fence is located.
- E. For the purposes of this section, the term "fence" shall mean and refer to an artificially constructed barrier of any material or combination of materials erected to separate, divide, enclose or screen areas of land and shall include a wall. [Amended 1-10-1994 by L.L. No. 1-1994]
