RESOLVED, that the Proposal of Roadwork Ahead, Inc.(the "Contractor"), for Road Improvements Project 2016-1 in the lump sum amount of \$294,000 is hereby accepted, subject to the receipt and approval by the Mayor of additional information requested from the Contractor, and (i) the Superintendent of Public Works is directed to issue the Notice of Award to Roadwork Ahead, Inc. (ii) the Mayor is authorized on behalf of the Village to execute and deliver the Agreement contained in the bid documents with the lump-sum amount of \$294,000 (the "Roadwork Ahead Agreement"), upon countersignature of such agreement by Roadwork Ahead, Inc., and it is further

RESOLVED, THAT the Mayor is authorized on behalf of the Village, and pursuant to the Roadwork Ahead Agreement, to increase the scope of the work covered by the Roadwork Ahead Agreement, up to an additional amount not to exceed \$65,000.00 at the same unit price as applies to the rest of the streets under the Roadwork Ahead Agreement.

The Mayor reported on the recent activities of the Public Works Report.

The Mayor gave an update on the LIRR Colonial Road Bridge project, detailing the causes of the recent delay in the paving of Grace Avenue and the process by which the resolution of the issue was resolved. Paving of Grace Avenue is scheduled to take place this week, followed by the opening of the bridge.

The Levy family of 10 Grosvenor Place and the Mones family of 27 Knightsbridge Road requested that the Board consider changing the permitted work hours for building permits to forbid work on Saturdays. The residents' request was directly related to a construction project going on at a neighboring property. The Board took no formal action. The Mayor suggested that the Levy and Mones families attempt to negotiate a mutually agreeable arrangement with the owners of the neighboring property.
