Adoption of Minutes

RESOLUTION 15-32

Upon motion of Deputy Mayor Sharkey, seconded by Trustee Pang, and unanimously approved, the following resolution was adopted:

Quotes for LED Street Lighting

The Board reviewed four (4) quotes for LED replacement bulbs for the Village's street lights. The Board determined that additional information, including warranty coverage and expected life of the replacement bulbs for each manufacturer, was needed from the two (2) vendors with the lowest quotes.

Decision reserved pending review of the additional information.

Drainage work on Schenck Avenue

Mayor Weinberg reported that the drainage pipe from the apartment building located at 2 Spruce Street which empties onto Schenck Avenue has been undermining the roadway. More than twenty (20) years ago, the Village attempted to make the owner of 2 Spruce Street responsible for connecting the drainpipe to the Village's storm water system. The owner would not agree to undertake the work necessary to redirect the water. The Village desires to fix the problem prior to repaving Schenck Avenue (scheduled within the next two (2) years). Mayor Weinberg was pleased to report that he has discussed this matter with the attorney for the owner of 2 Spruce Street and the owner has offered the Village \$5,000 towards the cost of a project to redirect the water.

RESOLUTION 15-33

Upon motion of Deputy Mayor Sharkey, seconded by Trustee Pang, and unanimously approved, the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED, that the Mayor is authorized to accept \$5000 from Spruce Tower Owners Corp. to be applied towards the project to redirect the water from 2 Spruce Street that is currently flowing onto Schenck Avenue, subject to an agreement with the property owner to be executed by the Mayor on behalf of the Village.
