# MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING <br> OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES <br> OF THE VILLAGE OF THOMASTON 

July 30, 2018

The Board of Trustees met on Monday, July 30, 2018 at the Village Hall, 100 East Shore Road, Great Neck, New York at 7:30 p.m..

Present: Mayor Steven Weinberg, Deputy Mayor James Sharkey, Trustee Jill Monoson, Trustee To-on Pang, and Trustee Burton Weston

Absent: None
The Mayor opened the meeting at 7:34 p.m.

## Revised plans for Tower Ford

On December 19, 2016, the Board of Trustees granted an Incentive Use Permit to Tower Ford to use the property located at 655 Northern Boulevard for the retail sale of automobiles. Plans for the project were presented during the public hearing and approved by the Board as part of the decision granting the Incentive Use Permit.

Tower Ford has since modified the original plans. Pursuant to the conditions of the Incentive Use Permit, any modification of the plans requires permission from the Board of Trustees.

Ron Zakary, R.A. of Zakary Hagemann Associates, Michael Rant P.E. of Bladykas \& Panetta, and Michael Rosano, Landscape Designer presented revised plans for the Tower Ford project at 655 Northern Boulevard.

Modifications to the building plan (drawings A-1, A-2, A-3 \& A-4, prepared by ZHA Architects dated 7/30/18) include:

- Addition of a basement for the storage of automobiles
- Addition of a mezzanine to be used by the sales department
- An increase in vertical height of the building, to accommodate the mezzanine (exact dimensions will be presented at the next meeting of Board of Trustees on August 6, 2018)
- Full fire alarm and sprinklers for building

Modifications to the site plan (drawings C-1, C-2, C-3, C-4, prepared by Bladykas \& Panetta dated rev. 7/27/18 and "Landscape Plan" dated 7/30/18) include:

- Addition of a ramp for the basement on the west side of the property
- A shift of the building footprint eighteen (18) feet to the east (to accommodate the ramp)
- Additional drywells for the basement area
- Modification of the landscaping on the west side of the property
- A reduction of six (6) parking spaces on the east side of the property

There was a short period of questions and comments from the Board. The Board, wishing to have an opportunity to further review the plans presented, will continue their review at the next meeting of the Board of Trustees on August 6, 2018 at 7:30 p.m.

## Purchase of Speed Limit Signs

The Board reviewed two written quotations for the purchase of twenty (20) $25 \mathrm{~m} . \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{h}$. speed limit signs (Attachment A). These signs are to be installed on all new street segments which were added to Village Code §196-36 Schedule VIII: Speed Limits by Resolution 18-52 on June 11, 2018.

## Community Forum

The Mayor welcomed the Village residents in attendance. The purpose of the forum was to seek input from the community as to whether the Board of Trustees should consider the repeal of §131-1 (C) of the Village Code which prohibits the use of gas powered blower equipment from May $1^{\text {st }}$ to September $30^{\text {th }}$. Notice of the meeting had been posted within the Village and an article about the meeting was published in the July $27^{\text {th }}$ edition of the Great Neck News. In addition, residents of the Village were invited to attend the meeting via an email notification through the Swift911 system.

A total of thirteen (13) residents were present. Two additional residents, who were unable to attend the meeting, sent their statements to the Board via email. Each resident was given an opportunity to state their opinion. The Mayor summarized the statements which were sent via email.

Among those in favor of the repeal of §131-1 (C) of the Village Code were residents of 7 Susquehanna Avenue, 5 Susquehanna Avenue, 265 Schenck Avenue, 17 Marshall Court, 8 York Drive and 177 Overlook Avenue.

Among those against the repeal of $\S 131-1(\mathrm{C})$ of the Village Code were residents of 8 Valley View Road, 10 Valley View Road, 3 Arbor Street, 9 Lodge Road and 22 Crescent Road.

The Board acknowledged the validity of the arguments presented by both sides. The Mayor thanked everyone for attending.
No action was taken by the Board at this time.
