Adoption of Minutes

RESOLUTION 12-60

Upon motion of Deputy Mayor Weinberg, seconded by Trustee Sharkey, and unanimously approved, the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED, that the minutes of the Board of Trustees meeting held on September 10, 2012 are hereby approved and accepted as amended.

Adoption of Holiday Schedule and BOT Meeting Schedule 2013

RESOLUTION 12-61

Tax Certiorari Settlement

Upon motion of Deputy Mayor Weinberg, seconded by Trustee Sharkey and unanimously approved, the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLUTION 12-62

RESOLVED, that settlement of the tax certiorari claims affecting Rothmann's of Great Neck LLC (661 Northern Boulevard) for the property know as Section 2 Block 140 Lot 793 for the tax year 2012/13 (in addition to the previous settlement for the years 2006/7 through 2011/12) for reduction in assessed value and refund is hereby approved as per the details in the letter from the Village Attorney Mr. A. Thomas Levin, dated September 18, 2012. In addition there is a three year moratorium on further filing as long as the agreed upon assessment is maintained.

SCAR (Small Claims Assessment Review) Decisions

The Board of Trustees was presented with the decisions of the Hearing officer as of August 24, 2012. Upon motion of Mayor Stern, seconded by Trustee Sharkey and unanimously approved, the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLUTION 12-63

RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees directs the Village Administrator to correct the tax roll with the new assessment indicated by the hearing officer and carry these new assessments forward into the 2013/14 tax roll. In addition, the Board approves the payment of refunds for the 2012/13 year reflecting the difference between the original and amended bills. The Village Administrator will issue refunds for the total amount of \$1,111.44 to the applicant's representative upon submission of proper claim forms (see Attachment C).
