Speed Limits

The Board revisited their previous discussion of reducing thee speed limits of certain roads in the Village from 30 mph to 25 mph and reviewed the revised technical memorandum from VHB Engineering, regarding placement of speed limit signs. The general consensus of the Board was in favor of amending the schedule of speed limits in the Village Code to designate a 25 mph speed limit on certain road segments within the Village. This item will be placed on the agenda for the November 21, 2017 meeting.

Elimination of the deductibility of State and Local Taxes (SALT)

The Board discussed the proposed federal tax reform which would eliminate the deduction for state and local taxes.

RESOLUTION 17-67

Upon motion of Deputy Mayor Sharkey, seconded by Trustee Weston, and unanimously approved, the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS Congress is giving serious consideration to eliminating the federal income tax deduction for state and local taxes;

WHEREAS this deduction, which has been in place for more than 100 years, is heavily utilized by residents of our community and our State;

WHEREAS New York residents already pay more into the federal treasury than the federal government returns to New York;

WHEREAS the state and local tax deduction is a fundamental principle of federalism and without it our residents would be faced with double taxation as they would be forced to pay federal income taxes on the taxes they pay to state and local governments;

WHEREAS this federal cost shift onto local governments would place extreme pressure on municipal budgets, including diminished revenue for essential local government investments, including public safety and public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS increased federal taxation and reduced municipal services will harm our local housing market, decrease home values and erode our local tax base,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Village of Thomaston expresses its strong opposition to any tax reform proposal that would eliminate the State and Local Tax (SALT) Deduction and urges Senator Schumer, Senator Gillibrand and Congressman Suozzi to join us in publicly opposing any such proposal.

Cooperative Purchasing

The Board discussed the possibility of participating in a purchasing cooperative such as US Communities and the National Joint Powers Association (NJPA). In order to do so, the Village would have to pass a local law to permit the award of a purchase contract based on best value. No decision was made pending discussion with the Village Attorney and further research to determine whether there might be sufficient cost savings opportunities to offset the expense of the passage of the local law.

New Business

The Mayor reported on the recent activities of the Public Works Department.

The Mayor reported that the Village, at the request of New York State Senator Elaine Phillips, is serving as a collection point for donations of bottled water for the "H2O Campaign for Puerto Rico." Senator Phillips has partnered with Island Cares for this relief effort.

The Mayor announced that Senator Elaine Phillips has awarded the Village a \$50,000 grant for improvements to the Village Hall parking lot.
