661 Northern Associates, LLC Application

RESOLUTION 18-92

Upon motion of Trustee Weston, seconded by Trustee Monoson, and unanimously approved, the following resolution was adopted:

Whereas, on June 18, 2018, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Thomaston adopted Resolution 18-55, granting an incentive zoning use permit to 661 Northern Associates LLC ("Applicant") with respect to premises 661 Northern Boulevard, Thomaston, New York; and

Whereas, Applicant has demonstrated that the required Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions was duly recorded in the office of the Nassau County Clerk, in form approved by the Village Attorney, on September 19, 2018; and

Whereas, on October 30 2018, Applicant submitted a check payable to the Village of Thomaston in the amount required by Resolution 18-55;

Tower Ford application

RESOLUTION 18-93

Whereas, on December 19, 2016, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Thomaston granted (the "Approval") an application from Spartan Petroleum Corp. and Tower Ford, Inc. for an incentive zoning use permit with respect to premises located at 655 Northern Boulevard, Thomaston, New York, also known as Section 2, Block 140, Lot 796 on the Nassau County Land and Tax Map; and

Whereas, the Approval contained various conditions of approval, among which were that Applicant was required to record a Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions, in form approved by the Village Attorney, on or before a date certain; and

Whereas, the said Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions was duly and timely recorded in the office of the Nassau County Clerk; and

Whereas, Great Neck Ford, LLC, dba Tower Ford, as putative successor in interest to Tower Ford, Inc., thereafter made application to the Board of Trustees for amendment of the Approval; and

Whereas, a public hearing with respect to the said application for amendment was duly held by the Board of Trustees on September 6, 2018, after which the Board of Trustees granted the requested amendments (the "Amended Approval"), on various conditions, including that certain documentation be provided to the Village, and an amended Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions be recorded in the office of the Nassau County Clerk, in a form approved by the Village Attorney, all within a specified period of time; and

Whereas, Great Neck Ford LLC, dba Tower Ford, has advised the Board of Trustees that it has been unable to accomplish compliance with all of those conditions required to be completed within the specified period of time, and has requested the Board of Trustees to amend the Amended Approval to extend the time to provide the required documentation and record the required Declaration; and

Whereas, the Amended Approval provides that the Board of Trustees may extend the time for compliance with the various conditions of approval contained in the Amended Approval, without the need for a public hearing; and

Whereas, the proposed amendment to the Amended Approval is not substantive in nature;

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Thomaston hereby finds and concludes that this application for an extension of time to comply with the specified conditions in the Amended Approval Is a Type II Action as provided in the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act, which requires no environmental impact review; and it is further

RESOLVED, that there has been no material change in circumstances since the adoption of the Amended Approval which would preclude the granting of the requested relief; and it is further

RESOLVED, that no prejudice will result to the Village of Thomaston, nor to any other interested party, if the requested extension of time is to be granted; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the time provided in the Amended Approval adopted on September 6, 2018 for Great Neck Ford, LLC, dba Tower Ford, to provide documentation, and to record a Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions in approved form, is hereby extended to and including sixty (60) days from the date of adoption of this resolution, and it is further

RESOLVED, in all other respects the terms and conditions of the Amended Approval shall remain in effect as adopted on September 6, 2018.
