## Draft Inter-municipal Agreement (IMA) with the Manhasset Bay Protection Committee (MBPC)

Mr. Finkston, 8 York Drive, expressed his concerns about fire hydrants being buried under snow and ice during the upcoming winter. Mr. Finkston wanted to know who was responsible for clearing the snow from the fire hydrants. Deputy Mayor Sharkey responded that the fire hydrants are owned by the Manhasset Lakeville Fire and Water District (MLFWD). The Village will follow up with MLFWD to determine the protocol for maintaining the hydrants free from snow and ice.
